The introduction, cross-references, and appendices emphasize the relations between the essays and explain how Davidson's views have developed.

He was already a known scholar; in addition to some papers in economics, the first two papers in this volume had already been published and had dazzled me by their originality and their combination of philosophical insight and technical competence. However, I am very glad I did not discourage him; whether he learned anything worthwhile I don't know, but we all learned much from him on the foundations of the theory of games and specifically on the outcome of bargaining.
